



Dress Code Policy

Driving Range, Putting Green
Clubhouse & Golf Course

Appropriate club attire is required at all times
in the clubhouse, on the driving range,
putting green & the golf course.

All members & their guests must adhere to the
New Dress Code Policy at all times.

Determination of appropriate attire
will be strictly enforced by club management & staff.

MEN

Shirts with collars & sleeves, long & short sleeve
golf specific mock turtleneck
(as deemed appropriate), are allowed.

Slacks or golf shorts
(at least mid-thigh in length) must be worn.

No denim, tank tops, bathing suits, sweat pants,
athletic shorts or short shorts are permitted.

Certain hemmed dress shirts
which are designed & intended to be worn
un-tucked will be allowed while dining in the Grille
or at certain specified
events at the clubhouse.

WOMEN

Dresses, skirts, golf shorts, slacks,
blouses & golf shirts are acceptable attire.

No denim, halter tops, tank tops, basic workout t-shirts,
bathing suits, sweat pants, athletic shorts,
short shorts or extremely short skirts are permitted.

HEAD WEAR

Golf hats, golf caps or golf visors worn appropriately
with bills facing forwards.
